



Just in case you haven't been out at 5:30am on a Tuesday mornings to watch our garbage delivery we have front dumping garbage trucks. They carry a front dumpster and the cans are picked up and dumped into it. This is open air and once it gets full the truck then lifts the dumpster up and empties it in the back of the truck. STREET PARKING

No junked or abandoned vehicles (including vehicles with expired license plate or vehicles which are non-functional). 91.23

On-street parking and yard parking are prohibited except during (i) inclement weather or (ii) driveway repair work or (iii) periodic gatherings, BUT any permitted on-street parking shall not restrict the safe passage of emergency vehicles or otherwise cause the existence of unsafe conditions. 70.20. (County Ordinance prohibits street parking during inclement weather. Vehicles will be towed at owner expense.)



In addition to City of Goshen ordinance 91.23 the county has an enforceable law of no parking within 30 feet of a stop sign, no parking in curves and no parking in intersections.
