Have you been exposed to or tested positive for COVID-19?

<p>If you have tested POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 and have SYMPTOMS:</p> <p>Isolate for</p> <p>10</p> <p>DAYS from the date symptoms began.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If symptoms fully resolve, isolation may be shortened and end after day 5 on the first day without symptoms. Wear a well-fitting face mask for 10 full days since the start of symptoms. Isolation should not be shortened if a mask cannot be worn properly and consistently. 	<p>If you have tested POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 and have NEVER HAD SYMPTOMS:</p> <p>Isolate for</p> <p>5</p> <p>DAYS from the date you had your test done.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wear a well-fitting face mask for 5 additional days. Isolation should be extended to 10 days if a mask cannot be worn properly and consistently. 	<p>If you are not Up to Date* with your COVID-19 vaccination and have been in CLOSE CONTACT with someone diagnosed with COVID-19:</p> <p>Quarantine for</p> <p>10</p> <p>DAYS from your last exposure.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Quarantine may be shortened to 5 days if you have no symptoms and test negative for COVID-19 on day 5. Wear a well-fitting face mask for 10 days from your last exposure. Stay home and get a test if symptoms develop.
<p>If you are Up to Date* with your COVID-19 vaccination and have been in CLOSE CONTACT with someone diagnosed with COVID-19:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You do not need to quarantine if you do not have symptoms. Wear a well-fitting face mask for 10 full days from your last exposure. Get tested for COVID-19 on day 5. Stay home and get a test if symptoms develop. 		

*Up to Date means a person has received all recommended COVID-19 vaccines, including any booster dose(s) when eligible.

COVID-19 BOOSTER RECOMMENDATIONS

Initial Vaccine	When can you get a booster?	Boosters are recommended for:
Pfizer	5 months after 2nd dose	Everyone 12 years and older
Moderna	5 months after 2nd dose	Everyone 18 years and older
Johnson & Johnson	2 months after single dose <small>*mRNA booster is preferred</small>

STREET PARKING

No junked or abandoned vehicles (including vehicles with expired license plate or vehicles which are non-functional). 91.23

On-street parking and yard parking are prohibited except during (i) inclement weather or (ii) driveway repair work or (iii) periodic gatherings, BUT any permitted on-street parking shall not restrict the safe passage of emergency vehicles or otherwise cause the existence of unsafe conditions. 70.20. *(County Ordinance prohibits street parking during inclement weather. Vehicles will be towed at owner expense.)*



In addition to City of Goshen ordinance 91.23 the county has an enforceable law of no parking within 30 feet of a stop sign, no parking in curves and no parking in intersections.
