

CITY OF GOSHEN COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES
August 19, 2019

The meeting of the City of Goshen Commission was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Bobby Thacker at the North Oldham Fire Department, Goshen Station, 1660 South Highway 1793, with the following members present:

Pledge of Allegiance

Minutes

Commissioner Hall motioned to approve the July 15, 2019, regular meeting minutes; Commissioner Rolfes seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Budget and Finance – Bill Rolfes

Rolfes motioned to approve the July 2019 financials, Hall seconded the motion. All voted aye to approve the July 2019 financials.

Rolfes reported the final amount received for Municipal Road Aid was \$18,577.46. The city spent \$8200 on snow removal which leaves \$10,377.46 in excess road aid for fiscal year 2018/2019. The clerk was instructed to check certificate of deposit rates and report next month. Rolfes stated the final June 30, 2019 financial reports are not quite ready yet but will be ready before next month's meeting.

Newsletter – Bill Rolfes

Rolfes stated he plans on putting a newsletter out October 1st and asked everyone to have any information they want included be sent to him by mid-September.

Drainage – Todd Hall

Hall reported representatives from QK4 were not able to attend tonight's meeting but are planning to attend next month.

Beautification – Bob Dearmond

Dearmond stated the irrigation control box has been replaced.

Playground – Bob Dearmond

Dearmond reported two broken swings have been replaced and another has been broken.

Ordinance Enforcement – Bob Dearmond

Dearmond stated 1115 Crestview has requested a code board hearing regarding dead tree and weeds.

Thacker stated Kentucky League of Cities is holding a webinar on Code Enforcement procedures. The city clerk, code board chairman, Jeff Mangan and Commissioner Dearmond are all registered.

Thacker stated Frank Rose's term on the code board has expired and asked commissioner's if they know of anyone interested in serving on the board to have them submit a letter of interest.

Website – Todd Hall

Hall stated the website is up and running, he is editing as he goes. Hall reported he will look into companies to host email accounts.

Architectural Control -

No new permits.

Street and Public Works –

Thacker reported twenty mailbox and newspaper boxes have been ordered. Broken tree limb on Club Drive has been removed at a cost of \$150. The commission decided to offer chipping service to all residents this year. The chipping service will take place on November 11th.

Sanitation – Bobby Thacker

Thacker stated he has been walking the streets on Monday nights marking broken trash cans to be replaced, so far he marked 20 cans on four streets. He anticipates completing the city in about three weeks.

Public Safety – Bobby Thacker

Deputy Fitzner reported Goshen has been pretty quiet, Pewee Valley had numerous car break ins the last few nights, reminds everyone to lock their cars.

Administrative Issues – Bobby Thacker

Thacker stated files should be ready to go to auditor by September.

Thacker stated iPads for the commission and clerk were approved in the budget and he would like to order them. Thacker motioned to spend up to \$5000 for the purchase of iPads. Rolfes seconded the motion, all voted aye. All iPads remain the property of the City of Goshen.

Old Business

The Commission discussed how to proceed with changes to code of ordinances section 50.01, an ordinance regarding placement and storage of trash cans. No decision was made.

New Business

Thacker gave first reading of Ordinance 5, 2019, an ordinance accepting the updated Code of Ordinances from American Legal.

Rolfes stated the commission included money in this year's budget for a City of Goshen 30th anniversary celebration. Rolfes stated the tentative date is April 25, 2020. Dearmond stated his newly formed resident committee may be able to help plan the celebration.
