

**CITY OF GOSHEN COMMISSION SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**  
**February 25, 2019**

The meeting of the City of Goshen Commission was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Bobby Thacker at the North Oldham Fire Department, Goshen Station, 1660 South Highway 1793, with the following members present:

**Minutes**

Commissioner Hall motioned to approve the January 14, 2019, special meeting minutes; Commissioner Morales seconded the motion, all voted aye to approve the January 14, 2019 minutes.

Morales motioned to approve the January 30, 2019 special meeting minutes, Commissioner Rolfes seconded the motion. Thacker, Rolfes Morales and Dearmond voted aye. Hall abstained. The January 30, 2019 minutes were approved.

**Sanitation – Bobby Thacker**

Thacker stated the city received three bids for sanitation services which were opened on February 21, 2019 at the clerk's office. Anytime Waste bid was \$12.50 per month for trash service, \$3.75 per month for city paid recycling and \$3.75 per month for resident paid recycling. Republic Services bid was \$11.95 per month for trash service, \$3.95 per month for city paid recycling and \$4.75 per month for resident paid recycling. Rumpke's bid was \$14.00 for trash services, \$7.00 per month for city paid recycling and \$7.00 per for resident paid recycling. Morales motioned to accept Republic Service's bid, Rolfes seconded the motion. All voted aye. The Commission discussed whether to continue city paid recycling or to have residents pay individually for recycling. Rolfes motioned to accept the option of city paid recycling, Morales seconded the motion. Rolfes, Morales and Hall voted aye. Thacker and Dearmond voted nay. Motion passed. The city will continue to pay for recycling services but residents will need to opt in to have recycling services. Rolfes stated the city will need to send a mailer to all residents informing them of the change requiring them to notify the city if they wish to have recycling service.

Rolfes motioned to approve the January financials, Hall seconded the motion. All voted aye.

**Drainage – Bob Dearmond**

Dearmond reported the city received a call regarding a sink hole in a sewer easement at 1003 Rollingwood. Dearmond stated Oldham County Sewer District ran a camera through the pipe and informed the sewer pipe is intact and therefore not their issue. Thacker reported the city doesn't

have a drainage easement. Dearmond stated he will go back to the sewer department and look into the matter further.

Hall reported three violation notices were sent this month. Hall asked Rolfes to include the junk car ordinance in the next newsletter.
