Commissioner Morales motioned to approve the June 20, 2022, meeting minutes. Commissioner Hall seconded the motion. Morales, Hall, and Thacker voted aye. Rolfes abstained.

Budget and Finance – Bill Rolfes

Rolfes reported June financial statements will be presented at the August meeting.

Rolfes motioned to approve a quote of up to \$7500 to Charles Veeneman, CPA to perform the annual audit. Morales seconded the motion, all voted aye.

Newsletter - Bill Rolfes

Rolfes reported the mayor sent out a newsletter.

Special Events – Bill Rolfes

The commission discussed plans for a special event in December.

Stormwater Mitigation/ Drainage – Todd Hall

Hall reported a final survey of the Harmony Landing/ Club Drive area scheduled for drainage improvements should take place in the next few days.

Hall stated he will add the budget and tax ordinances to the website.

Architectural Control – Doug Morales

Morales reported an architectural control permit was issued for a shed at 1035 Rollingwood Lane.

Street and Public Works – Doug Morales

Morales reported 6 streetlight outages have been called into LG&E.

Ordinance Enforcement – Bobby Thacker

Discussion of an ongoing ordinance violation on Hollendale Way.

Parks – Bobby Thacker

Thacker reported there was some vandalism at the park, picnic tables and bench flipped over. Thacker stated he is working on getting Wi-Fi and Ring cameras.

Thacker stated a new request for bids for construction of a multi-sport court will run in the newspaper on July 14, 2022. Bids will be opened on July 28th and a special will meeting will be held on August 2nd to review and possibly award a contract.

Sanitation/ Snow Removal – Bobby Thacker

Semi annual junk pickup is scheduled on August 11th.

Beautification – Bobby Thacker

Administrative Issues – Bobby Thacker

Thacker motioned to repeal Municipal Order 02-2022, an order regarding use of ARPA for police services. Rolfes seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Thacker read Municipal Order 04-2022, an order providing for the use of ARPA funds for park improvements. Hall motioned to approve Municipal Order 04-2022, Rolfes seconded the motion, all voted aye.

Property tax and rental license fee bills will go out on August first. All property tax bills are eligible for a 10% discount if paid by 8/31.
