Minutes

Commissioner Morales motioned to approve the May 20, 2019, regular meeting minutes; Commissioner Dearmond seconded the motion, all voted aye to approve the minutes. Commissioner Hall motioned to approve the June 3, 2019 special meeting and public hearing minutes. Morales seconded the motion, all voted aye.

Budget and Finance –

Drainage – Todd Hall

Hall stated he has spoken with the homeowners on Rollingwood regarding a small sink hole in their side yard and they are going to contact a contractor. Commission discussed a drainage problem in an easement at 1011 Rollingwood Lane. Hall will look into the issue and report back. Hall reported he hopes to have a follow up meeting with QK4 on storm water next week.

Dearmond stated a code board hearing is scheduled for tomorrow. Commission discussed complaints received regarding enforcement of the placement of trash can ordinance. Commission will review the ordinance and discuss any possible changes next month.

Website – Todd Hall

Hall reported he's found a new website administrator to update city website and provide hosting. Thacker motioned to approve moving city website services to FreeLogo.com at a price of \$99.95

per month, with website rebuild and hosting to begin immediately. Morales seconded the motion, all voted aye.

Architectural Control – Doug Morales

Morales reported he has issued architectural control permits for a rebuild of a shed at 1022 Rollingwood and a fence at 12106 Wayside.

Street and Public Works – Doug Morales

Commission discussed how to proceed forward with replacing mailbox posts throughout the city. Morales stated the city will need to do some tree trimming this fall.

Sanitation – Bobby Thacker

Thacker reported there were some issues with residents being able to sign up to continue with recycling services through Republic Services, he stated he believes all those issues have been resolved. Thacker stated the last day of city wide recycling is June 25th. Republic will pick up cans from all residences that have chosen not to continue.
