June 21, 2021

The meeting of the City of Goshen Commission was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Bobby Thacker via Zoom with the following members present:

Minutes

Commissioner Morales motioned to approve the May 17, 2021 meeting minutes. Commissioner Rolfes seconded the motion. Morales, Rolfes and Thacker voted aye. Minutes were approved.

Budget and Finance – Bill Rolfes

Rolfes reported May and June financial statements will be presented at the July 19th meeting. American Rescue Plan funds have not been received yet.

Commissioners Mangan and Hall joined the meeting at 7:02 pm.

Parks – Bill Rolfes

Rolfes reported the pavilions are complete and the electrician will start work on June 23rd.

Beautification – Bill Rolfes

Rolfes reported new flowers are going to be planted, the new banners have been installed and he is searching for a new irrigation company after having numerous issues with the current company.

Stormwater Mitigation/ Drainage – Todd Hall

Hall motioned to approve a proposal of \$5100 from OHM Advisors to design and develop bid specifications for the Harmony Landing Rd and Club Drive drainage project. Morales seconded the motion. All voted aye. Hall stated MSD has a project planned to remove a lift station on Club Drive. The MSD project will not impact the city drainage project.

Hall reported the drainage pipe replacement at 1034 Rollingwood has been completed. Risinger Construction also repaired a pipe separation at Meadowridge Trail and Harmony Lane at a cost of \$1000.

Website- Todd Hall

Hall stated he added the Republic Services app to the city website.

Architectural Control – Doug Morales

No report.

Street and Public Works – Doug Morales

Thacker questioned when work will resume on sign replacement and street post painting. Morales stated he will work with the city clerk to find someone to complete the project.

Rolfes stated he had city maintenance replace the street signs at Rollingwood and Springmeadow.

Ordinance Enforcement – Jeff Mangan

Mangan reported 12 to 15 letters were sent out last month, mostly for yard and street parking. Mangan stated fines are being assessed on a home on Harmony Landing Rd for severe peeling paint and rotted wood.

Public Safety – Jeff Mangan

Mangan reported police hours have been adjusted for the summer months.

Sanitation – Bobby Thacker

Thacker motioned to extend the contract with Republic Services for 2 years. Hall seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Rolfes gave second reading of Ordinance 3, Series 2021, an ordinance adopting a budget for fiscal year 2021/2022. Hall motioned to approve, Mangan seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Mangan motioned to approve a contract for police services through the Oldham Count Sheriff’s Office. Rolfes seconded the motion. All voted aye.
