

**CITY OF GOSHEN COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES  
May 20, 2019**

The meeting of the City of Goshen Commission was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Bobby Thacker at the North Oldham Fire Department, Goshen Station, 1660 South Highway 1793, with the following members present:

**Minutes**

Commissioner Morales motioned to approve the April 15, 2019, regular meeting minutes; Commissioner Dearmond seconded the motion, all voted aye to approve the minutes. Commissioner Hall motioned to approve the April 25, 2019 special meeting minutes. Dearmond seconded the motion, all voted aye. Morales motioned to approve the May 8, 2019 special meeting minutes. Hall seconded the motion, all voted aye.

Thacker motioned to appoint Hall to oversee drainage and Dearmond to oversee code enforcement by their agreement. Hall seconded the motion, all voted aye.

**Budget and Finance –**

Thacker stated Commissioner Rolfes is out of town and unable to attend. Thacker motioned to approve the April financials, Hall seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Thacker announced the first reading of the budget and tax ordinance has been delayed because Oldham County PVA reassessed the city this year. Thacker stated overall values increased by 8 million dollars and the city will be lowering the city tax rate.

**Drainage – Todd Hall**

Hall stated he checked easement maps after receiving a complaint of drainage issues and the city does not have an easement on the left side of 12021 Springmeadow Lane.

Hall stated the city has hired a consultant to enable the city to oversee its storm water reporting. He will schedule a follow up meeting with the consultant soon.

**Beautification – Bob Dearmond**

Dearmond reported flowers have been planted and the irrigation has been repaired.

**Playground – Bob Dearmond**

Dearmond stated city maintenance added mulch to the playground.

**Ordinance Enforcement – Bob Dearmond**

Dearmond stated a code board hearing is scheduled for tomorrow.

**Website – Todd Hall**

Hall reported he's still looking into other website providers and will report back at next month's meeting.

**Architectural Control – Doug Morales**

Morales reported he has not heard back from the homeowners on Wayside or Rollingwood concerning architectural control permit requests.

Morales asked if the landscaping agreed upon by the owners and neighboring property owners of 1005 Rollingwood was ever completed. Thacker stated it has not been completed and asked the clerk to pull the agreement for follow up.

Morales said he received a request for a driveway expansion at 1023 Harmony Landing Road. The owner wants to widen the driveway to extend in front of home. Morales stated he just wanted to make sure there are no restrictions on the driveway being in front of home. Commission agreed there aren't any restrictions.

Morales stated he will be issuing a permit for a prebuilt shed at 1022 Rollingwood.

The commission discussed mud that is washing into the street from under a driveway on Rollingwood.

**Street and Public Work – Doug Morales**

Morales stated the sample mailbox post the city ordered is at the clerk's office if the commissioners want to take a look at it.

**Sanitation – Bobby Thacker**

Thacker stated a postcard will go out to all residents informing them of changes to recycling.

**Public Safety – Bobby Thacker**

Thacker reported there was an incident with a juvenile on a mini bike.

Deputy Fitzner asked Thacker to send something out reminding everyone to lock their cars. Fitzner said they have received many reports of theft from unlocked cars in the Crestwood area.

**Administrative Issues – Bobby Thacker**

Thacker announced he has called a special meeting for June 3<sup>rd</sup>. The meeting will consist of a public hearing on municipal road aid fund expenditures, set the 2019 tax rate, first reading of 2019/2020 budget and tax ordinances.
