## MAINTAIN YOUR DITCHES AND CULVERTS

Roadside ditches are narrow channels that slow the flow of runoff water to help prevent localized flooding. Residents are responsible for maintaining the ditch and culvert in front of their homes.



## Don't put off ditch and culvert maintenance

In most cases, homeowners are responsible for residential ditch culvert maintenance and repair. Repairs can be very costly, so it's in your best interest to make sure your culvert is properly maintained at all times.

Ditches and Culverts tend to fill with natural debris. Weeds, grass and other summer growth, as well as fallen leaves can quickly fill a ditch or culvert. Silt, which accumulates over time, can also cause drainage problems. Organic matter should never be allowed to reduce water flow or drainage in the culvert by more than 20%. If culverts are not properly maintained in the fall or this 20% guideline is exceeded, serious drainage problems can occur in the spring when winter snows melt.

If your culvert is adjacent to a public roadway or another property, routine inspections and culvert maintenance are key to avoiding flooding that could damage the roadway or an adjacent property. Removing silt, organic debris, trash, vegetation and “volunteer” trees should be a part of your culvert maintenance routine. Culvert inlets and outlets should be examined for signs of deterioration, damage or soil erosion.

### As a property owner:

- Routine maintenance of ditches and flushing of culvert
- Removal of debris
- Removal of root infiltration caused by a private tree
- Remove silt and sand build-up in culverts
- Maintain boulevard, including cutting grass, weeds, and alike
- Replacement of deteriorated or damaged culverts





# SPRINGMEADOW PARK

## PARK RULES

**PLEASE ENJOY YOUR CITY PARK. FOR SAFETY AND TO ALLOW OTHERS TO ENJOY THIS PARK. THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY.**

### **PARK HOURS: THE PARK IS OPEN DAWN TO DUSK**

**CHILDREN:** PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR SUPERVISING THEIR CHILDREN AND PROTECTING THEM FROM HARM.

**PETS AND ANIMALS:** LARGE ANIMALS AND HORSES ARE PROHIBITED. ALL ANIMALS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL. DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES. ALL ANIMAL EXCREMENT MUST BE CLEANED UP.

**NO SKATEBOARDING:** SKATEBOARDING, BICYCLES, SCOOTERS, SKATES ECT. STRICKLY PROHIBITED ON COURTS AND PAVILIONS.

**NO LITTERING:** DISPOSE OF ALL WASTE/TRASH IN TRASH CONTAINERS. DO NOT PLACE ASH FROM GRILL IN TRASH CONTAINERS.

**NO ALCOHOL:** NO ALCHOHOL OR GLASS CONTAINERS ALLOWED IN PARK EXCEPT FOR SCHEDULED EVENTS.

**NO FIREWORKS:** FIREWORKS ARE PROHIBITED UNLESS SPECIFICALLY PERMITTED AS PART OF A SCHEDULED EVENT.

**FIREARMS:** DISPLAYING OR DISCHARGING FIREARMS IS PROHIBITED.

**FIRES:** FIRES ARE ONLY ALLOWED IN THE PROVIDED GRILL FOR YOUR CONVEINENCE. NEVER LEAVE LIT OR SMOLDERING GRILL UNATTENDED.

**NO CAMPING:** NO OVERNIGHT CAMPING PERMITTED.

**PARKING & MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES ALLOWED ON PARK PROPERTY. THIS WILL INCLUDE CARS, TRUCKS, MOTOR BIKES, MOTORIZED SCOOTERS, GOLF CARTS, ECT.

**NO VANDALISM:** VANDALISM WILL BE PROSECUTED. IT IS ILLEGAL TO DEFACE, DAMAGE OR DESTROY CITY PROPERTY.

**NOISE:** AMPLIFIED MUSIC IS NOT ALLOWED IN PARK EXCEPT FOR SCHEDULED EVENTS.
