Minutes

Commissioner Rolfes motioned to approve the October 18, 2021 meeting minutes. Commissioner Hall seconded the motion. All voted aye. Minutes were approved.

Stormwater Mitigation/ Drainage – Todd Hall

Steve Emly, OHM Advisor's, reported the Harmony Landing drainage project was rebid and two bids were received. E-Z Construction \$175,076. Bill Risinger Construction \$228,974. Steve stated the bids are over the city's original estimates of \$160,000. Emly suggested it maybe possible to cut back or delay some of the project. The commission determined funds are available and it would be cheaper to have all the work completed at once. Hall motioned to award E-Z Construction the Harmony Landing Drainage Project at a maximum bid of \$175,076. Mangan seconded the motion. All voted aye. Construction will take place in 2022.

Budget and Finance – Bill Rolfes

Commissioner Rolfes stated he reviewed the October 2021 financials and motioned to approve. Hall seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Parks – Bill Rolfes

Rolfes reported wreathes and garland will be added to the pavilions at the park.

Rolfes stated LG&E will donate some trees to the park.

Rolfes stated only one plumber came out to bid on the water line for the park. Stinnett Plumbing bid \$6750 to run the water line and install two hydrants. A water meter from Louisville Water is not included in this bid. Thacker motioned to approve up to \$6800 to Stinnett Plumbing for installation of a water line and two hydrants. Mangan seconded the motion. All voted aye. Thacker motioned to approve \$1375 for a water meter at Springmeadow Park. Hall seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Beautification – Bill Rolfes

Rolfes stated the low voltage lighting has been added to the island at Club Drive. Christmas lights are partially up.

The clerk has talked to LG&E, and they informed her they will remove the stumps and seed and straw the area at Harmony Landing Road and US 42 when they complete the tree removal and pole installation.

Special Events – Bill Rolfes

Rolfes reported he had enough left in the special event budget to rent portable heaters. Rolfes asked Morales if he could assist in getting the Boy Scouts to volunteer at the event to maintain the fire for smores.

Website- Todd Hall

Hall reported he will add a map of the city to the website.

Architectural Control – Doug Morales

Street and Public Works – Doug Morales

Morales reported tree trimming and chipping service has been completed.

Morales stated we are still waiting on a call back from the insurance company on the damaged radar sign.

Ordinance Enforcement – Jeff Mangan

Mangan reported a few parking violations were sent and one home on Meadowridge Trail with violations for junk vehicles and trailers is being cleaned up.

Public Safety – Jeff Mangan

Mangan gave a summary of last months activity.

Thacker reported Friends of Oldham County Fair have completed the two litter pickups in the city.
